

## Overview

We are currently under COVID-19 Alert Level 1. This means that while we do not have to follow strict guidelines in order to run surfing events, we should continue to follow best practice.

## National Scholastic Championships – Kaikoura (5-9 October)

This event will be proceeding under Alert Level 1 and we recommend following these guidelines.

Everyone to follow the Government Guidelines:

- Stay at home if you are sick
- Wear a face mask when travelling and on land if you choose - bandanas, buffs are acceptable
- Keep track of where you have been
- Wash your hands
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow
- Clean surfaces
- Maintain physical distancing

### Pre event

- All entrants, management and parental support will be databased prior to the event
- All guidelines will be submitted to the Kaikoura District Council for approval
- QR codes will be produced for daily check ins by participants, management, parents and spectators
- Pre event meeting will be for team management and team captains only
- A PPE event pack will be on stand by
- Kaikoura Health Services will be notified of the event and a managed pathway for any team member requiring medical attention will be strictly followed
- All teams will be provided with clear guidelines in regard to the requirements

### During Event

- All teams will be allocated a parking area that they will use for the week
- Limit congregating with other teams
- No handshakes pre and post heats
- Social distancing of 1.5m should be observed
- All judges to wear masks if not in immediate bubble

- Officials area will be cordoned off
- Use all of your own equipment – towels, gear, wax, water bottles, sunscreen
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the beach marshal

#### Post event

- Prize giving will be held outdoors to maximise social distancing

#### Team Management

For the event to proceed, it is important that team management assist with following all COVID-19 guidelines. The success of the event will rely on all officials, participants, management and parents doing their part to keep everyone safe.
